

School Supply List 2025-2026

Students at Avalon will require the following basic school supplies for this year. Further specific supplies may be communicated to students in the first week of school by their assigned teachers.

General (all students grade 7-9, all programs)

- Backpack or bag that can fit easily in a locker
- Combination lock, good quality (Master or Dudley)
- *Good quality locks can be purchased at the office for \$9.75
- □ Lined paper (four pkgs)
- Blank paper (one pkg)
- □ 2 Three ring binders, two inch rings, NO ZIPPER BINDERS!
- Dividers for binder (two pkgs)
- Graph paper (cm), (one pkg)
- □ 6 white board markers and an eraser (old socks work best)
- Pens (blue, black, red)
- □ 1 Package (12 or more) Pencils
- Personal Pencil Sharpener
- □ 4 Highlighters
- Erasers
- □ 1 fine tip Sharpie, 1 thick Sharpie
- □ Scissors, coloured markers, pencil crayons, glue sticks, pencil sharpener
- □ 1 pkg post-it notes
- □ 1 Journal for English Language Arts
- *For ease of convenience \$5.50 will be added to your child's school account & they will receive a journal once it has been paid.
- Scientific calculator (Texas Instruments 30X (preferred model), Sharp, Casio)
- □ Headphones
- Athletic wear for Phys Ed (Running/Athletic shoes (no skate shoes, chucks or flat bottom shoes), change of clothes, cloth bag to carry them)
- □ Water bottle (no squirtable Gatorade types unfortunately they are repeatedly misused and cause unnecessary disruption. Any squirt type water bottles will be sent back to the student's locker for them to take home.)
- Personal Chromebook (optional)
